 WHEREAS, the Clay Local School District Board of Education (“Board”) is undertaking the construction of a new PreK-12 school building, which is being designed and constructed through the Exceptional Needs Program in partnership with the Ohio School Facilities Commission; and  
 WHEREAS, the School District facilities are available for use by the general public, and the Board intends to continue this policy with the new PreK-12 School; and  
 WHEREAS, the Board is seeking LEED certification for the PreK-12 School based upon the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED for Schools rating system; as part of the LEED for Schools rating system, the Board can achieve one LEED credit if the Board ensures that at least three (3) of the following spaces included in the PreK-12 School are accessible to and available for shared use by the general public: Auditorium, Gymnasium, Cafeteria/Cafetorium, one or more Classrooms, and Playing Fields; and  
 WHEREAS, the Board, subject to the conditions outlined in the Resolution, wishes to make each of these spaces available for shared use by the general public.
