1. Awards or recognition of students and/or staff:

3. Current enrollment stands at 314 in grades 6-12 (288 in 7-12 we were at 284 in 7-12 at the beginning of last year) (262 at this time 2 years ago).
4. Congratulations to all the sports teams on their seasons thus far. These young people are representing our district and their families very well. They are exceptional people and define the term Student-Athlete. The records are as follows:
 - i. Congratulations to the Clay Golf Team and their coach Mrs. Cayton on their season (Thus far).
 1. In SOC play, after 2 matches the team total is 371 in 3rd place, 3 strokes behind Western and 27 behind the leader Notre Dame.
 2. The final SOC match is tonight at Big Beaver GC in Picketon.
 3. Zach Jackson is 2nd in the SOC individual race with an 83, 5 strokes behind the leader. Jacob Crosier has a 97, Conner Phipps 98, Taylor Swayne 101, and Isaac Moore 105.
 4. Team finished 6th at the Ironton Invitational with a team score of 369. Kole Murphy finished in the top 10 with an 80.
 5. The team has competed in a total of 15 matches and has finished 1st in 1 match and 2nd in 9 other matches. Regular season play ends this week with matches on 9/21 @ Shawnee State GC and 9/22 @ the Elk's Country Club.
 6. Division III Sectional Tournament is Wednesday, September 28, 2011 At Shawnee State GC. Clay golfers will tee off at 8:30 am. Three teams and 3 individuals (not on qualifying teams) will advance to the district tournament.
 7. Coach Cayton is pleased with our golfers. They have no seniors, 2 juniors (the only experienced returning players), 3 sophomores and 5 freshmen.
 - ii. Girls Volleyball –Varsity is 8 and 2 (6-1 in the S.O.C), JV is 7 and 3 (6-1 in the S.O.C.).
 1. The girls have been battling a series of injuries which have been difficult.
 2. Their # setter is out and the some of the younger players are improving each match.

- iii. Boys' and Girls' soccer has competed well even though they are also battling serious injuries to key players. The soccer team is 4-2-2 (2-0-2 in SOC).
- iv. Junior High Volleyball – 8th grade is 4 and 2 (4-2 in SOC I), 7th grade is 3 and 1 (3-1 in SOCI).
- v. The Cross-Country teams are competing well and improving.
