1. Awards or recognition of students and/or staff:

1. Congratulations to all the winter sports teams on their hard this basketball season. The winter sports season is a very lengthy and difficult one. Regardless of the win loss record I am proud of the efforts of our student athletes this season.
 - i. I would like to thank The Clay Jr. & Sr. High Cheerleaders and their advisors (Mrs. Hammond and Mrs. Webster – HS and Lesley Shiltz – Jr. High) for their hard work this season.
 - ii. The Boys' Basketball team (coached by Jack Trainer, Arnold King, Adam Betten) finished the season at 2 and 19 (2-12 in SOC) on the year. The JV team finished 11 and 9 (9-5 in SOC) the freshmen finished 1-4.
 - iii. The Girls' Basketball team (coached by Kevin Castle, Mark Pelfrey, and Eric Gray) has had a really good season thus far. The girls record stands at 15 and 7 on the year (12-2 in SOC play). 
